Madrone Trail is seeking a half time Interventionist whose duties include:

- Tracking students' district assessments (I-ready in Reading and Math) and state test scores (Smarter Balanced) in grades 2 through 8
- Leading the School Level Team (SLT) to identify students who are in need of extra academic support
- Working closely with the School Director and Faculty Chairs with the School Improvement Plan identified in the charter agreement that identifies benchmarks for grades 3 through 8 in reading and math for both the district assessments and state standardized tests
- Scheduling the required intervention times for students who are not testing on grade level, preferably during their regularly scheduled Skills classes for that subject area
- Designing intervention to address the specific area of concern
- Tutoring students, mostly one on one or in small groups
- Working with our authorizing district, Medford School District, to follow all documentation requirements to refer students for special education services
- Collaborate with teachers on 504 plans for students who qualify
- Participating in all district and school level trainings and in-service days
- Regularly reviewing student progress, evaluating and documenting all interventions, make changes as needed
- Working collaboratively with parents and teachers to support students with unique learning styles
- Determining, with input from the SLT, the best course of action for a struggling student (integrate them back into Skills classes, continue interventions, refer to the district A&E team)
- Attend at least half of the regularly scheduled faculty meetings
- Keep clear paper records as well as input student information into the MESA system used by the district.
- This position reports to the School Director and works closely with charter's district liaison to meet benchmarks identified in the School Improvement Plan in order to stay in compliance with our charter

The successful candidate will possess knowledge of and/or experience with Waldorf Education as well as the Common Core, experience working with students with unique learning styles and the ability to work as part of a team. Strong interpersonal and organizational skills are required.

Madrone Trail Public Charter School is completing its 10th year with healthy enrollment, a strong faculty and committed parents. Located on a beautiful rural campus, there are gardens, a field and track, with well lite classrooms. The salary scale has a base of \$18,500 for a half time position, with steps up for training, degrees and years of experience. There is also the possibility of combining this position with a half time middle school support position for a qualified applicant who is strong in math and language arts in the Common Core for 6th, 7th and 8th grade.
