



Secondary Student Consent and Waiver

Medford School District Network (MSDNet) and Internet Access

The District believes that the benefits to educators and students from access to the Internet, in the form of information resources and opportunities for collaboration, far exceed any disadvantages of access. The District does not have control of the information on the Internet, although it attempts to provide prudent and available barriers to illegal or inappropriate materials.

By signing the Consent and Waiver form agreement, I and my parent(s) or guardian(s) agree to abide by the following rights and responsibilities:

1. My use of the Medford School District Network (MSDNet), and Internet access through this network, must be consistent with the Medford School District's primary goals. My rights and responsibilities are explained in School Board Policy IIBG and IIBGA-AR.
2. I will not use MSDNet for illegal or inappropriate purposes of any kind.
3. I will not use the MSDNet to access or transmit threatening, obscene, or harassing materials. The District will not be held responsible if I participate in such activities.
4. I will not use MSDNet to interfere with or disrupt network users, services or equipment. Disruptions include, but are not limited to, distribution of unsolicited advertising, propagation of computer worms or viruses, and using the network to make unauthorized entry to any other machine accessible via the network. I will print only to my local designated printer.
5. I will not use the school computer network for personal use or to make money.
6. I will not use the computer network to copy or use information that may need to have the owner's permission. I will abide by copyright law and fair use guidelines.
